## Cardinals safety Wilson to chair Scottsdale Healthcare pro-am golf classic

Arizona Cardinals safety Adrian Wilson was named honorary chairman for the second year of the Scottsdale Healthcare Golf Classic, which will help support health services for children of low-income families.

The April 11-12 pro-am tournament will be held McCormick Ranch Golf Club with proceeds benefiting Scottsdale Healthcare's Neighborhood Outreach Action for Health program, which operates a mobile health clinic and school-based clinics for children and their families in the Northeast Valley.

Some 3,000 uninsured and underinsured children and their families benefited from the program in 2007, organizers said. The annual pro-am tournament has raised more than \$2.5 million for Scottsdale Healthcare services, hospital facilities and equipment over its 23-year history. Businessmen Ken Gordon and Marty Wegner are tournament co-chairs.

The tournament includes a \$50,000 professional purse and Waterford crystal awards for amateurs. Teams are comprised of an amateur foursome and one professional. The amateur entry fee of \$800 includes green fees and golf carts, player's gift package, lunch both days, and an invitation to the gala/dinner/dance/auction and the awards reception. Professional entry fee is \$300, waived for professionals who bring their own team.
