Hospital workers give \$403K to charity

A record \$403,000 in pledges and gifts toward community service agencies was raised through Scottsdale Healthcare's annual employee giving campaign, Share & Care 2008, hospital representatives announced in a statement.

Proceeds go to the Scottsdale Healthcare Foundation, Valley of the Sun United Way and Mesa United Way.

Money going to the United Way agencies will help pay for services such as food, clothing, shelter and after-school programs, while funds going to the foundation will support areas such as nursing education, the Virginia G. Piper Cancer Center and employee assistance, said hospital spokeswoman Alice Sluga.

The previous record was \$401,000, set in 2007, Sluga said.
