The centers provide scientifically-based medical information and health education to help make informed decisions about health and healthcare.

Health, wellness and prevention information is available through books, videos, newsletters, Internet resources, and pamphlets. The centers' professional, friendly staff provide personalized research for patients and families.

The weekly "Ask the Healthcare Expert" and monthly "Focus on Your Health" programs give patients and families an opportunity to speak with healthcare professionals and receive information on health, wellness, disease prevention and treatment of specific medical conditions.

The Werner Support & Resource Center at the Virginia G. Piper Cancer Center at Shea provides patients, families and caregivers the most comprehensive and current cancer-related information. Staff members work with cancer patients and their families to provide individualized research.

## General Information

Scottsdale Healthcare's Health Sciences Libraries have expanded resources and services over the years to meet the growing needs of its users.

Whether you're a physician, staff member, patient, family member or a member of the greater Scottsdale community, you can access a wealth of evidence-based medical and health information from a variety of credible sources.

This focus supports clinical, educational and research activities throughout the hospital system and the community. The libraries now provide access to users on- and off-site. Professional library staff members are eager to assist in your information and research needs.



## Services

- **Ready-Reference** - Quick, thorough information on patient care, education, administration or other work-related areas.
- **In-Depth Reference** - The library has access to all National Library of Medicine databases and other medical databases for more in-depth information, including literature searches, with a 24-hour turnaround (*except on weekends*).
- **Interlibrary Loan** - Requested materials not owned by our libraries can be borrowed from other local, regional or national sources.
- **Public Computers** - Each library is equipped with PCs for physicians and staff. Internet access, Microsoft Office products and other hospital programs are provided.
- **Training** - Instruction and orientation is provided on use of library materials and databases.
- **Book Purchase** - Books can be ordered for personal or departmental use at a discount. Please ask a staff member for more information.
- **Patient/Family Information** - The Health Information Centers support this area. Please contact one of the Health Information Centers for patient education needs.
- **Speakers' Bureau** - This service coordinates with physicians and hospital staff to educate the public on health and wellness. Please call 480-323-3847 for more information.

## Resources

- **Databases** - Access to the following databases is provided through the Arizona Health Information Network (AZHIN):  
Medline, CINAHL, EBM-Reviews, Cochrane databases, Ebsco Health Business, StatREF (*electronic textbooks*)  
UpToDate, an evidence-based clinical decision tool is provided by Scottsdale Healthcare.  
  
All databases are accessible through the Health Sciences Libraries intranet page (under Departments & Programs). A login for remote access can be obtained from the library.
- **Book Collection** - Circulating collections cover all medical areas, including the basic sciences, nursing, allied health and healthcare administration. Electronic textbooks and medical references are accessible at the Health Sciences Libraries intranet page.
- **Journal Collection** - The libraries provide access to more than 600 print and electronic journals in the medical, nursing, allied health and management fields through the intranet.
- **Online Library Catalog** - A searchable online database of materials found at the Health Sciences Libraries and the Health Information Centers is available at the library's intranet page and on the hospital's website ([www.shc.org](http://www.shc.org)).
- **RefWorks** - A Web-based citation management software is available for bibliographic and resource sharing needs of all hospital staff and physicians. Please contact the library for more information.
