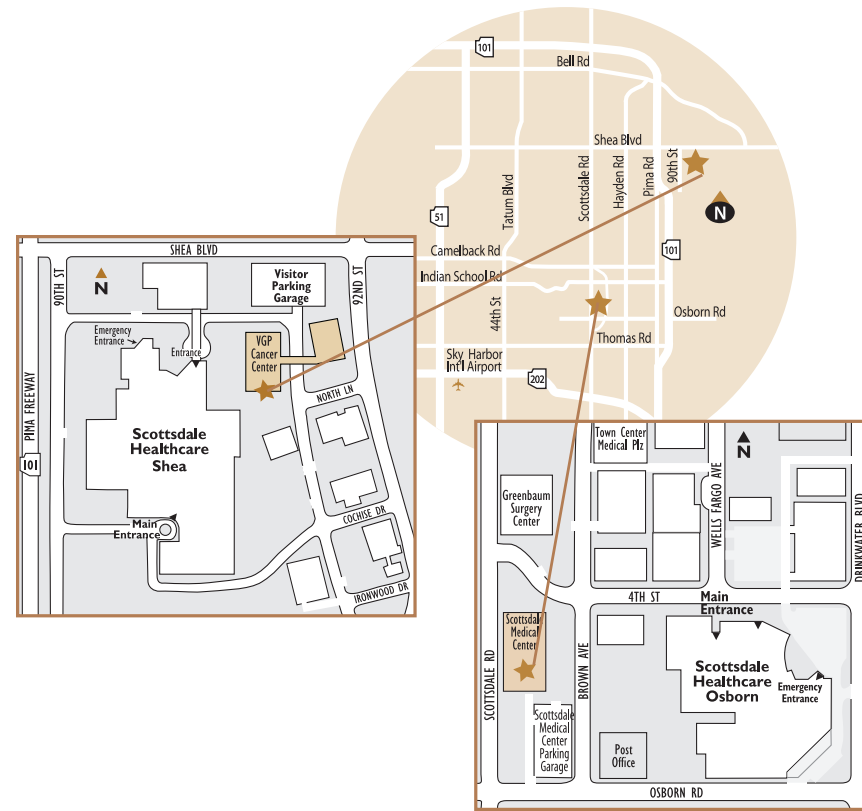

### Building the Bridge Between Care and Cure

#### Treatment and Research in One Location

The Virginia G. Piper Cancer Center includes a 69,000-square-foot clinical building, the Diane and Bruce Halle Pavilion, and a 35,000-square-foot Debi and Jerry Bisgrove Research Pavilion. Connecting the two buildings is a covered pedestrian bridge which is truly symbolic of “Building the Bridge between Care and Cure.”

The Halle Pavilion houses community oncology physician offices, cancer diagnostic and treatment services. Support services include genetic risk assessment, nutritional counseling, lymphedema therapy and exercise rehabilitation, a cancer resource center, and Tina’s Treasures. Complementary therapies such as art and music therapy, yoga and stress management are also available.



#### The Diane and Bruce Halle Pavilion

A host of clinical and supportive services are available in the Virginia G. Piper Cancer Center’s Diane and Bruce Halle Pavilion. Patient comfort, convenience, and support are an integral part of the Virginia G. Piper Cancer Center.

The Cancer Care Coordinator at the Virginia G. Piper Cancer Center is an advanced practice nurse with expertise in the care of the oncology patient and their family. The Coordinator provides a personalized, one on one approach to meet patient's individual needs.

#### Cancer Research and Clinical Trials

Patients who meet eligibility criteria have the opportunity to participate in trials of new cancer drugs. These new therapies are offered in Phase I and II clinical trials through the TGen Clinical Research Services (TCRS) at Scottsdale Healthcare.

Through collaborative partnerships, TCRS includes physicians, research nurses and data managers who evaluate patients to determine if they are candidates for clinical trials. Together they work with the community oncologists to treat and follow patients who are on clinical trials.

Community-based clinical trials play an important role in furthering research of new agents that have shown definite promise in treating cancer and improving survival. These studies provide the final phases of testing new therapies.
